# **Report on Home Demolitions and Forced Evictions of Amharas in the Newly Established Sheger City Administration of the Oromia Region: A City that Denies Amhara Existence in their Homeland of Ethiopia**

## **Summary of the Findings**

The Amhara Association of America (AAA) has been conducting human rights investigation on the ongoing ethnic-based demolitions of homes and forced evictions in the newly established Sheger City Administration since January 1st, 2023. The investigation revealed the existence of widespread and ethnically motivated forced eviction, which is considered by the Committee on Economic Social and Cultural Rights (CESR) in its General Comment No. 4 as prima facie incompatible with the requirements of the International Covenant on Economic Social and Cultural Rights (ICESCR), and other human rights violations including violation of the right to adequate housing, the right to privacy and to security of the home, the right to property, the right to family life, the right to life, the right to equality and non-discrimination, freedom of movement and the right to choose one's residence, the right to education of children, loss of sources of

livelihood and denial of the rights to information and popular participation, and arrest or imprisonment for opposing the forced eviction. In sum, the following are the major findings of this investigation:

- Tens of thousands houses of non-Oromo ethnic groups (most of whom are belonging to the Amhara ethnic group) were demolished in the newly-established Sheger City Administration of Oromia Region. For instance, over 9,300 houses belonging to non-Oromo owners (most belonging to Amhara owners) were demolished in Jemo Terara Medihanialem, Fanuel Church, Haji Anba, Enku Gabriel, Lideta, Lencho Sefer, Anfo-Mariam, Ertu Teklehaymanot, and Gorsebe areas of the newly established Sheger City Administration alone.
- There were killings, infliction of bodily injury, arrests and enforced disappearances of those opposing the forced eviction. In this regard, although the exact number of civilians killed throughout the eviction period is not yet known, at least three individuals were killed between January 1-30, 2023 and many more thereafter. Several others were injured, arrested and be victims of enforced disappearance.
- Hundreds of thousands of people have been forced to fled from their homes, became homeless and live in dire conditions either in Internally Displaced Persons (IDP) camps, streets, the rubbles of their homes or low-level rented houses. Thousands of other non-Oromo ethnic residents (especially Amharas) remain under threat of further forced evictions.
- As the ethnic based demolition of homes and the process is short of the international and national human rights standards, the AAA calls the government of Ethiopia to stop the ongoing ethnically motivated forced eviction, to comply with its human rights obligations of respect and protect the rights of the victims and to redress the victims for the violations they sustained. The AAA also calls the international community including the UN and AU to give due consideration of the situation and

pressure the Ethiopian government to immediately cease the ethnically motivated demolition of homes and to respect and protect the rights of its citizens.

## **1 Background**

Since the coming into power of Abiy Ahmed Ali as Prime Minister in 2018, the Amhara people living in Oromia Regional State have faced continued and widespread human rights violations and have been subject to crimes of genocide, crimes against humanity and war crimes, which are regarded as the most serious crimes of concern to the international community. The violations are committed either by the action or inaction of the government. Every atrocity committed against the Amhara people such as the ethnic-based mass killings (massacres), forced evictions and other deliberate persecutions are neither investigated nor given proper acknowledgement by either the Federal Government or the Oromia Regional State. Appeals for investigation have always got to no avail. Such systemic and structurally targeted attacks against the Amhara are being committed with the aim of expelling all Amharas from the Oromia Region and Addis Ababa as well as to weaken the Amhara so that they would not be able to claim their legal and legitimate interests. To this end, the Oromia Special Forces (OSF) and Oromia Police, under the leadership of Oromia Regional President Shimelis Abdisa, continues to commit ethnic cleansing against Amharas residing in the Oromia Region, as well as allowing non-state actors like the Oromo Liberation Army (OLA) and Qeerro (ultranationalist Oromo youth) to do the same in various parts of the Oromia Region. This ethnic cleansing program consists of ethnic-based massacres, forced evictions, and deliberately inducing conditions of life designed to result in the destruction of the Amhara population as a whole or in part, among other actions.

The gross human rights violations against the Amhara in Addis Ababa and its outskirts are

being committed by the Oromo Prosperity Party (OPP) with a policy of making the capital dominated by ethnic Oromo (an execution of planned demographic change) so that they would be able to dominate Ethiopian politics indefinitely and eventually make Addis Ababa part of the Oromia Region, a wrongly claimed ownership by the Oromo extremists, Oromo based political parties and the ruling OPP itself. To this end, the Oromia Regional State administration and the Oromo-led Addis Ababa City administration has most recently agreed on the demarcation of Oromia Region and the Addis Ababa City Administration. The biased demarcation enabled the Oromia Region to take large areas from Addis Ababa. Immediately after the demarcation, the Oromia Regional State government has restructured the then Oromia Special Zones around Addis Ababa to Sheger City Administration, a name previously used to refer Addis Ababa. The newly-established Sheger City consists of Sebeta, Burayu, Legetafo, Legedadi, Gelan and Sululta Sub-Cities within which some kebeles of Addis Ababa were included. And the Oromia Regional State is now conducting mass forced evictions against the non-Oromo ethnic groups, the great majority of whom belongs to the Amhara ethnic group in the newly-established Sheger City. The demolition of homes and forced eviction is being conducted with the help of the OSF, Oromia Police, Oromia Militias, Qeerro and the sub-city administrations.

The AAA's investigation revealed that the ongoing campaign of forced eviction and demolition of homes are being conducted in complete defiance of relevant national and international human rights laws and standards, without any consultation, adequate notice, compensation or alternative housing being offered to the victims. It is also unfortunate that these measures have been accompanied by acts of violence, such as killings, injuries, and arrests and resulted in the violation of various rights of the victims.

Following this systemic, illegal and discriminatory demolition of homes and forced

evictions, the right to housing, the right to life, the right to education, the right to residence, the right to employment and other basic and fundamental rights of citizens has been violated. Peoples including women, children and the elderly have been displaced from their homes. Grave psychological, social and economic problems have also been witnessed. The AAA has investigated and documented the human rights violations following the systematic and widespread house demolition campaign and forced eviction by employing methodologies such as interviewing victims, focus group discussion, document review and video and photo analysis. On the basis of the investigation, this report thus addressed the scale of the demolition and forced eviction, the procedural and substantive rights violations, and the impact of the demolition and forced eviction on the victims.

## **2 The Scale of Demolition of Homes and Forced Eviction against Ethnic Amharas in the Newly Established Sheger City**

The AAA's investigation shows that the demolition of homes and forced eviction against the Amhara living in most areas of the newly established Sheger City was started on January 1st, 2023 and are still ongoing. The places where such demolition of houses belonging to the non-Oromo ethnic groups, the greatest majority of whom are ethnic Amhara, and forced eviction were started are the Jemo Terara Medihanialem and Fanuel Church (Alem Bank) neighborhoods, which were previously under Woreda 3 of the Kolfie Keraniyo Sub-City of the Addis Ababa City Administration and which are now included within the Sebeta Sub-City of the newly-structured Sheger City Administration. In these places, around 3,090 houses (1,625 houses around Fanuel Church area and 1,465 houses around Jemo Terara Medihanialem area) were demolished by the Sheger City

Administration. As an interviewee told to the AAA that:

*“the victims of the demolition have resided in the area for more than 20 years. However, to the dismay of everyone, the Oromia security forces with the youths has demolished the houses of non-Oromo, most of which belongs to the Amhara individuals, without even providing reasoning for victims and with no prior notice. The hatred and disrespect the demolition task force have towards the Amhara people is unimaginable.”*

As the same interviewee said, while demolishing the houses, the demolition task force said,

*“they will never allow Amhara to live in Oromo land. As you (the Amhara individuals) came to this area holding 50 cent plastic, we will make sure you return to where you were, with that 50 cent plastic only.”*

Since then, the demolition of homes and forced eviction have become the day-to-day task of the newly established Sheger City Administration. It has been conducted with the presence of an established task force including the Oromia Region security forces and local Oromo youth.

The other place where home demolitions were carried out on January 1st, 2023 is the Enku-Gabriel area. This area was previously within Woreda 1 of the Nefas Silk Lafto Sub-City of the Addis Ababa City Administration, and is now included within Kebele 8 of the Sebeta Sub-City of the newly established Sheger City Administration. As one informant told the AAA, the house demolitions in this area started on the early morning of Sunday, January 1st, 2023, at 5 am. He said that:

*“starting from Sunday, January 1st, 2023, the Oromia police and the Oromia Special Force have been forcibly destroying homes belonging to Amhara. Together with the police those who sold their land to us decades before came holding a gun to destroy houses and displace the Amhara.”*

In this area, at least 250 houses belonging to non-Oromo residents (mostly Amhara) were demolished in a day and residents were forced to leave their homes. Sources confirmed to AAA that their complaint on the matter to the Addis Ababa City Administration and the Federal Government has obtained negative reception and they were informed to go back and to lodge their complaint to the newly established Sheger City Administration, the same administration that ordered the ethnically motivated demolitions to begin with and that conducted the demolitions without respecting the procedural safeguards to which the victims are entitled, such as prior notice and consultation. As the interviewees told the AAA, on the following day, January 2nd, 2023, in a similar area the demolition taskforce put an “X” sign on houses belonging to Amhara owners and warned to commence the demolitions on the next day. Accordingly, on Tuesday morning (January 3rd, 2023), the demolition taskforce consisting of hundreds of local youth, representatives from the Sheger City Administration, the Oromia Police, and OSF came and started demolishing the houses. As a victim interviewee told the AAA, the demolitions was ethnic based, because the houses of Oromo’s on which an “X” sign was put on Monday were left untouched on the next day after the demolition taskforce spoke with the Oromo owners in

Oromiffa. On Tuesday at least 600 houses were demolished and it was ethnically motivated. The interviewee described the situation in the following manner:

*“On Monday they painted an ‘X’ sign on houses for the next day’s destruction. On the morning of Tuesday, hundreds of local youth, police and special police forces came to the Enku-Gabriel area (southern/betachignaw side). At that time, they drove a bulldozer for the destruction of the houses. When local residents from the southern side prevented them to drive the bulldozer deep into residential houses, they changed direction and came to Enku-Gabriel area (northern/yelayignaw side). When they come from the northern side of Enku-Gabriel they were firing a gun at people who tried to block their way. On their arrival in areas named ‘Amhara Sefer’ they started demolishing houses. They abscise the tin roof and doors of houses and took the tin to the Oromia Region with the help of 11 FSR trucks. There were few houses belonging to the Oromo owners but these houses were not destroyed.”*

The other areas where demolitions were carried out are Ertu-Teklehaymanot, which was previously within Woreda 1 of Nefas Silk Lafto Sub-City of the Addis Ababa City Administration and is now included within the Sebeta Sub-City of the newly established Sheger City Administration, and Haji Anaba. The demolition of houses in these areas started on January 2nd, 2023. In these areas at least 2,200 homes belonging to Amhara owners homes were demolished.

Lencho Sefer and Lideta area, places previously within Woreda 3 of Kolfie Keraniyo Sub-City of the Addis Ababa City Administration and now demarcated within Geda-Fiche Woreda of Furi Sub-City of the newly established Sheger City, are the other areas where demolition of houses and forced eviction was carried out. The demolitions in this area started on the early morning of January 11th, 2023. In this area more than 2,635 (at least 1,300 houses in Lencho Sefer and 1,335 in Lideta area) houses mostly belonging to ethnic Amhara and Silte owners were demolished. This resulted in more than 3,000 individuals becoming homeless from the Lencho Sefer area only.

Anfo-Mariam and Gorsebe, which were previously within Kolfie Keraniyo Sub-City of the Addis Ababa City Administration and now within Burayu Sub-City of the Sheger City Administration, are areas where demolitions occurred. In these areas, demolitions started on January 1st, 2023 and resulted in the demolition of at least 350 houses of non-Oromo owners, the majority of which were ethnic Amhara, Dorze, and Tigrayan. The demolition was carried out with the help of bulldozers.

The demolition of Amhara houses was also carried out in the Dire, Jewasa, Lemi and Woregenu areas of the Legetafo Sub-City of the Sheger City Administration. The demolition started on January 21st, 2023 and resulted in the demolition of at least 184 Amhara houses (100 in Dire, 49 in Jewasa, 30 in Lemi and 5 in Woregenu). A witness, who was severely beaten by the Oromia Police without even knowing the reason, told the AAA that there are organized groups with 15 to 20 members, consisting of at least two security force personnel (Oromia Police or OSF members) that lead the group and the rest are local Oromo youths (Qeerro) that persecute the Amhara residents by demolishing the houses, beating the owners and looting their property. They targeted Amharas whom they think could oppose their expansionist ideology in systematically cleansing Amhara from the newly-established Sheger City. The data obtained from the informants shows that in the majority of incidents the demolition of houses were conducted starting from late night between 4:00 and 5:00 am. The informant added that:

*“The organized group came at night, they selected houses to be demolished mostly those belonging to the Amhara who have influence in the community. Then they beat the residents who try to resist/oppose the demolition, detached the roofs, doors, and windows of the houses and transported the tins to unknown places. They categorically made clear that the land belongs to ethnic Oromo so that Amhara are not allowed to live in the newly established Sheger City. In addition to the demolition of homes, more than 40 Amhara*

*civilians were arrested and taken to an unknown place. The beating of Amhara by the security forces is also the new norm in the newly established Sheger City.”*

Since then (January 21st, 2023) the demolition of houses and forceful evictions of Amharas have intensified in Legetafo-Legedadi Sub-City and resulted in the demolition of tens of thousands houses belonging to Amhara owners, leaving hundreds of thousands Amhara homeless.

The other sub-city where the demolition of houses and forced eviction of the Amhara is carried out is the Sululta Sub-City of the newly-established Sheger City Administration. Like the other places, the demolition was carried out since January 2023 and the specific areas where the demolitions were conducted are Pente Mekabir, Melegeta, Qasu Woserbi, Shifine and Ashewa Meda areas. The victims are also non-Oromo residents and the vast majority are Amhara. The Oromo houses with a similar situation of the demolished houses were left untouched, showing the ethnically motivated nature of the demolition campaign. This has been confirmed by a victim from Melegeta area whose demolished

house was found in the middle of his two Oromo neighbors.

### **3 Violations of the Procedural and Substantive Rights of the Victims throughout the Campaign of Demolition of Houses and Forced Eviction**

The forced eviction and ethnic-based demolition of houses in the newly established Sheger City Administration is carried out in violation of a number of rights, both substantive and procedural, that are recognized in the ratified human rights treaties such as the International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination (CERD), Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women (CEDAW), Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC), International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights (ICCPR), ICESCR, Convention against Torture and Other Cruel Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment (CAT) Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CRPD), the African Charter on Human and Peoples' Rights (African Charter), African Charter on the Rights and Welfare of the Child (ACRWC), the Protocol to the African Charter on Human and Peoples' Rights on the Rights of Women in Africa (Maputo Protocol) and the Protocol to the African Charter on Human and Peoples' Rights on the Rights of Older Persons in Africa, and national laws. It violates, directly or indirectly, the full spectrum of civil and political as well as economic, social and cultural rights including the right to equality and non-discrimination, right to life, freedom from cruel, inhuman and degrading treatment, the right to security of the person, the right to adequate housing, the right to non-interference with privacy, home and family, freedom of movement and to choose one's residence, the right to health, the right to education, the right to work, the right to an effective remedy, and the right to property. These violations, some of which are discussed below, can be directly and indirectly attributed to the way evictions are decided, planned, and carried out, the use of harassment, threats, violence or force and the result of the evictions.

---

### 3.1 The Demolition was Conducted without Prior Notice to the Victims

Regardless of the type of houses required to be demolished, governments are expected to give prior notice for the victims whenever they plan to do so. Such obligation of the government is provided in the Expropriation of Land Holdings for Public Purposes, Payments of Compensation and Resettlement Proclamation No. 1161/2019 and Urban Land Lease Holding Proclamation No. 721/2011. The Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights in its General Comment No. 7 (1997) regarding forced evictions also indicated this obligation of the government by stating that “adequate and reasonable notice for all affected persons prior to the scheduled date of eviction should be given”. Despite such express legal obligation, almost all of the houses were demolished without giving prior notice to the house owners and without giving them alternative houses as well as the necessary time for finding alternative housing themselves, to collect and take their property, and to appeal/challenge against the demolition decision of their houses. This has been confirmed by a number of interviewees of the investigation. For instance, one of the victims from Legetafo-Legedadi Sub-City, a 35-year-old carpenter with five family members, explained the situation (the absence of prior notice) in the following manner:

*“I bought land in 2007 and constructed a house soon after. I lived there, in the Yeka Sedin area of Legetafo, for 16 years. When we heard rumours about the demolition of houses, we asked the city administration and they denied the rumors and informed us not to worry about it, saying that nothing would happen to us. But later, on January 26th, 2023, they came to our village and began taking down each house one after another by bulldozers. They did not give us any prior notice. They were a group of special forces (OSF), state militias and youths (Qeerro).”*

A similar story was told to the AAA by another three Amhara victims from Kersa and

Dire Dale areas of Legetafo-Legedadi Sub-City, all of whom are daily laborers and have three or more family members. They were not given prior notice before the demolition of their houses. The victims told the AAA that the demolition taskforce was not even patient enough to give them a few minutes to retrieve their property from their houses.

### **3.2 Existence of Looting of Properties of the Victims**

As revealed by the interviewees, the house demolitions were accompanied by looting and taking away of belongings of the house owners or holders. The tins of the demolished houses have been taken by the demolition taskforce and some other belongings have also been looted. This has been done with the intent that the Amhara victims would not be able to retrieve property they (demolitions taskforce) believed belongs to the Oromia Region, which is, as indicated above, unequivocally said by the demolition taskforce themselves. An interviewee has explained this situation in the following manner:

*“Even they (the demolition taskforce) did not wish us to take out our properties. They detached tins and looted properties inside for themselves. They took 240 pieces of tin of mine from my house alone. There are also my neighbors whose house utilities were taken. They told us to take only what belongs to us, which according to them is the yellow plastic that we brought while we settled there and the rest of our properties are theirs.”*

The interviewees in the Dire Dale and Kersa areas of Legetafo-Legedadi Sub-City have also confirmed the existence of taking of tins and looting of other properties of the victims by the demolition taskforce. They expressed their unwillingness to allow the victims to take their belongings including the tin from the demolished houses. The extent of their humanity, as expressed by the victims, is that they sometimes forced the victims to sell their property at a cheap price. Those who tried to collect their belongings were beaten.

### **3.3 Ethnically Motivated and Discriminatory Nature of the House Demolition Campaign**

According to General Comment No. 7 of the Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, evictions should never be carried out in a discriminatory manner or render someone homeless or vulnerable to other human rights violations. Despite the existence of legal frameworks and the treaty monitoring body's general comments, the house demolition campaign carried out in the newly established Sheger City Administration is found to be discriminatory and ethnically motivated. As the AAA ascertained from

different sources including the victims, the demolition campaign has highly affected ethnic Amhara individuals living in the newly established Sheger City Administration and left hundreds of thousands homeless. According to many observers, it is being conducted with the aim of persecuting Amhara residents and forcing them to leave Oromia Region and Addis Ababa, so that a demographic change (which was said by the then president of Oromia Region, Mr. Lemma Megersa, in a meeting some years ago) that would allow an Oromo hegemony to be achieved within Ethiopia or facilitate secession and creation of a Greater Oromia State in East Africa. To this effect, the Sheger City Administration authorities go to the extent of threatening ethnic Oromo individuals not to rent houses for those who became homeless due to the demolition campaign. This has been affirmed by an interviewee in the following way:

*“The demolition was ethnically motivated and the targets are Amhara residents of the newly established Sheger City. The houses belonging to Oromos are not primary targets for demolition though they are in a similar situation as the Amhara houses. If an Amhara’s house is surrounded by an Oromo’s houses, the Amhara house would be demolished selectively and the others would be left untouched. This has happened to my sister, although her house was surrounded by houses owned by Oromo individuals. The demolition taskforce even threatened Oromo owners not to rent houses to non-Oromo. They did not even allow us to live in rented houses within Sheger City. They did not want to see us (Amhara) in the newly-established Sheger City; they want to see us all leave the city. They arrested me and eight others, they beat us, forced us to do exercise, and to kneel for a day for taking a photo and video of the demolished houses. After all this, they also deleted every picture and video of the demolished houses we took. Finally, they released four of us and took the rest (5) individuals to an unknown place. We did not know their whereabouts and their fate to date. They were taken, because*

*pictures and documents advocating for Amhara rights were founded on their phone.”*

As explained by another interviewee, the demolition taskforce went so far as to promise not to demolish a home if the Oromo wife promised to separate from her Amhara husband. She accepted their offer and she is now living in their house in Legetafo-Legedadi Sub-City while her husband is living in a rented house in Addis Ababa. Moreover, as revealed by the witnesses, asking questions or speaking in Amharic, which is the working language of the Federal Government, where the demolition taskforce is found was considered as a crime and resulted in the detention of those who spoke Amharic in some areas, such as in the demolition campaign carried out in Sululta Sub-City. Speaking Oromiffa was mandatory to present questions or express concerns regarding the demolitions. Furthermore, in some places, such as in Sululta Sub-City, being an Oromo is enough to save one’s home from demolition. As exposed by witnesses, although an “X” sign was placed on their homes the day before demolition, the Oromo residents were able to save their homes by talking with the demolition taskforce in Oromiffa. After speaking with them, the demolition taskforce placed an “Oro” sign next to the “X” sign on houses found to belong to ethnic Oromo owners.

A source from the Melegeta area, whose name is not mentioned for security reasons, reported as follows:

*“My house was in the middle while there were ethnic Oromo residents on the right and left side of my house. Nevertheless, only my house was demolished, and no harm was done to the Oromo community. There are also newly constructed houses in the area belonging to the Amharas that have been evicted without any justification.”*

In sum, the existence of unjustified discrimination against the non-Oromo victims, the great majority of whom are ethnic Amharas, the ill-treatment of the Amhara victims including beatings, arbitrary arrests, killings, harassment, insults and humiliation, and the selective demolition of houses of ethnic Amharas while leaving similarly situated houses of ethnically Oromo individuals, shows that the demolition campaign is short of the international and national requirements on non-discrimination. It violates the basic right to equality and non-discrimination of the Amhara victims.

### **3.4 Violations of the Rights to Property, Housing and Security of Tenure**

The Constitution of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia (FDRE Constitution) has recognized the right to property under Article 40. Although this right has not been included in the ICESCR, it has got place in Article 17 of the UDHR. Besides,

this right is recognized in Article 14 of the African Charter. These human rights instruments prohibited arbitrary deprivation of the right to property. As far as the right to housing is concerned, the FDRE Constitution has not included it in its substantive part. It rather has addressed it in its Article 90(1), which contains the national policy principles and objectives concerning access to housing, among other social objectives. The right to adequate housing is also recognized as the component part of the right to adequate standard of living under Article 11(1) of the ICESCR and Article 25(1) of the UDHR. As the Committee on ESCR clearly indicated in its General Comment No. 4, the government is required to confer legal security of tenure to those lacking such protection as it guarantees legal protection against forced eviction. In this regard, the type of tenure, whether it is informal settlement or not, is immaterial. The widespread demolition of houses and forced eviction by the Sheger City Administration is thus in violation of the constitutionally guaranteed and internationally recognized rights to property and housing of the victims. As indicated above, the demolition is accompanied by looting, which further affirms the violation of the right to property of the victims.

### **3.5 Violations of the Right to Life and Security of Person**

The right to life and the right to security of person are the fundamental rights of everyone, which are recognized both in the international and national human rights documents. They are recognized in Article 15 and 16 of the FDRE Constitution and Article 6 and 9 of the ICCPR, respectively. They are also recognized in Article 4 of the African Charter and Article 3 of the UDHR. Despite all these legal guarantees, ethnic Amhara people were subjected to death and bodily harm by the demolition taskforce and Oromia security forces during the house demolition campaign. There were killings and beatings of those opposing the forced eviction. Although the exact number of civilians killed in connection with the house demolition campaign is not yet known, at least three individuals were killed between January 1-30, 2023 and many more thereafter. Besides

---

this, 52 individuals, among whom 12 were girls, were beaten by the Oromia Region Security Forces and sustained bodily injury, some of which were serious in nature. A victim whose home was demolished in the Legetafo area spoke about the bodily injury inflicted by the demolition taskforce and described it in the following way:

*“They detached 150 pieces of tin from my house and my friend’s house and took it for themselves. Then they destroyed the houses with bulldozers. They did the same to our neighbors too. They also collected materials from the wall and fences and took them away, loading them in a truck. They pounded me with a hammer above my nape when I attempted to retrieve my properties. At the time, my wife was nine months pregnant. She collapsed upon witnessing the beating, was taken to the hospital, and was compelled to undergo an operation to deliver a child prematurely. She remains unwell even now.”*

### **3.6 Arbitrary Arrest and Enforced Disappearance**

The house demolition and forced eviction carried out in the newly established Sheger City Administration were accompanied by arbitrary arrest and enforced disappearance. There were a number of individuals that had been arrested by the Oromia Region Security Forces and, as indicated above, the whereabouts of some of them are still known. According to the interviewees, Kassaye Direslet, Priest Mezgebu, Mekuria Muche, Walelign Melaku, and Behailu Mamo were among those who had been arbitrarily arrested by security forces on January 2nd, 2023. They were arrested in the Kuru Woreda 04 Police Station of Sebeta Sub-City. Such practice is in violation of the right to liberty of the victims, which is guaranteed by the FDRE Constitution and ratified international human rights instruments.

---

### **3.7 Violations of the Right to Privacy**

The right to privacy is recognized under Article 26 of the FDRE Constitution, Article 17 of the ICCPR and Article 12 of the UDHR. This right, among others, guarantees right holders not to be subjected to arbitrary interference to his/her family and home. This recognized right of the Amhara victims were pervasively violated in the newly established Sheger City by the demolition taskforce and Oromia Region Security Forces.

### **3.8 Violation of the Right to Education**

The right to education is recognized under Article 13 of the ICESCR, Article 26 of the UDHR and Article 17 of the African Charter. This right, among others, guarantees children to attend school in a way that is acceptable, affordable, and adaptable. However, the forced eviction resulted from the demolition campaign by the newly established Sheger City Administration has forced tens of thousands of children to dropout from school in Burayu, Sebeta, Legetafo, Sululta and other areas where the demolition campaign has been widely carried out. They are displaced with their parents and are situated far from their registered schools. This clearly violates the children's right to education. An interviewee has described this situation in the following way:

*“After my home was demolished in the Legetafo area, I fled to Debre Birhan together with my wife and my three children. We sheltered together with our families. My children’s entire schooling was interrupted following the demolition of our home. There are thousands of victims who are living in similar circumstances with us in Debre Birhan.”*

### **3.9 Violation of Freedom of Movement and Residence**

The forced eviction and demolition of houses carried out by the Sheger City Administration has displaced hundreds of thousands of individuals, the great majority of whom are ethnic Amhara, and therefore violated their freedom of movement and right to choose their residence, which is recognized under Article 32(1) of the FDRE Constitution, Article 12(1) of the ICCPR, Article 13(1) of the UDHR and Article 12(1) of the African Charter.

---

## **4 Unacceptability and Illegality of the Government’s Justification for the Demolition of the Houses and Forced Evictions**

According to the Sheger City Administration, as revealed by the authorities in various media reports, the house demolition campaign within the newly established Sheger City is being carried out with the aim of clearing what they called “illegal settlers” and freeing the illegally occupied lands. The government thus alleged that the demolition is only against the informal settlers that have no title for their ownership. In fact, the prohibition of eviction is not absolute. There are situations where the government could be unable to avoid the eviction. Even in such situations, however, the government is required to comply with its human rights obligations and should carry out the eviction in full conformity with human rights standards and in a manner that prevents or mitigates any negative consequences. Indeed, necessary evictions and resettlement should leave those evicted better off. Accordingly, evictions need to comply with certain conditions to be justified. These are: it must be carried out in the most exceptional circumstance; It should be carried out after all feasible alternatives to eviction that address the exceptional circumstance are explored in consultation with the affected community; and it should be carried out after due process protections are afforded to the individual, group or community.<sup>1</sup> Evictions should never be carried out in a discriminatory manner or render someone homeless or vulnerable to other human rights violations. None of these conditions are satisfied in the Sheger City Administration’s demolition campaign and the forced eviction has made hundreds of thousands homeless and subjected them to widespread human rights violations.

Besides this, the informal settlement nature of the tenure does not allow the government to

demolish houses and carry out forced eviction as it pleases. As expressly stated in General Comment No. 4 of the Committee on ESCR, the government is expected to provide legal security of tenure to all persons regardless of the type of tenure they have in so far as they are lacking it, so that everyone has legal protection against forced eviction. Therefore, the existence of informal settlement alone cannot be a persuasive justification for carrying out a house demolition campaign as the Sheger City Administration is doing.

Moreover, most of the homes demolished in the newly established Sheger City are constructed before twenty and more years and have access to basic infrastructure such as water and power. The demolition of such type of homes is manifestly illegal for two reasons: firstly, it is illogical to say that they are informal while the houses have access to the basic services provided by the government such as water and electricity (power). Secondly, there is a national law, the Urban Land Lease Holding Proclamation no. 721/2011, that obliges the government to regularize them.<sup>2</sup> The Sheger City Administration's forced evictions and some of its home demolitions are therefore in contravention of this law and thus unlawful.

## **5 Impact of the House Demolitions and Forced Evictions: Displacement, Social, Economical, and Psychological Calamity on the Victims**

The demolition of houses and forced eviction in Sheger City has brought economic, social, and psychological hardship on the victims. The socio-economic problem following the demolition of homes in the newly established Sheger City is immense. Following the demolition of tens of thousands of homes, the victims, the majority of whom were

Amhara, were forcefully evicted from their homes. This resulted in the homelessness of hundreds of thousands of citizens adding oil to the already acute housing problem in Addis Ababa and its outskirts. Most of the victims are from the poor section of society who could not obtain houses for rent or are unable to afford housing otherwise. Some of the victims got very tight rooms and houses for rent and others are temporarily sheltered with their relatives or friends in various places including in Addis Ababa and Debre Birhan. Handfuls of victims fled to Debre Birhan and took shelter in at least two camps. The Debre Birhan authorities have now expressed their concern about the influx of the displaced persons and said that Debre Birhan has ran out of capacity to host any more IDPs. The victims were prohibited by the Sheger City Administration to stay in the city either as IDPs or living in rental houses. Thousands of children, whose family houses were demolished and displaced, are also dropped out of their regular schooling. As a result of the extensive demolition campaign, victims were disconnected from the social life they had with their neighbors in the area where their homes were destroyed. This dire living situation of many of the displaced persons was affirmed by various interviewees. For instance, a displaced person from Legetafo, who is temporarily sheltered in Bereyo Bealewold Church in Debre Birhan, described the situation in the following way:

*“I can reasonably guess that more than 30,000 Amhara homes have been demolished in the newly established Sheger City, which resulted in the displacement of hundreds of thousands of Amharas. This resulted in complete social disintegration of families. Economically, we lost all our belongings including our homes.”*

He added that:

*“My home which was situated in Legetafo Legedadi was worth more than two million ETB; I was living there together with my wife and six children. After our home was demolished and we were forced to leave the area, we were*

*living in a church for months. There are around 58 individuals including women and children here in the church. The situation is extremely bad; we are crippled economically and socially which resulted in a huge psychological problem for us. Unimaginable trauma, suffering and psychological misery are being endured by the children. They have not slept peacefully for a long time.”*
